NEWS FROM THE NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM (NCM) May 2023 Dave Jones

Reminder that May is the month to honor our nation's military. "Vets 'N Vettes," presented by Mobil 1 is scheduled for May 11-13, with numerous events and activities planned. Check my last month's article for more detail. To honor the military, the Museum is offering free admission for military personnel, active and retired, and one guest during the entire month of May.

There is always something happening at the National Corvette Museum. Current on-going exhibits include:

<u>Nostalgia Gallery</u>-This gallery presents realistic scenes reflecting Corvette's early history. Step back in time to Main Street, which includes a mid-20th century barbershop, Mobil service station, '60s Chevrolet dealer showroom and the St. Louis Assembly Plant line.

<u>E. Pierce Marshall Memorial Performance Gallery</u>-Features of this gallery include digital projection, interactive touch screens paired with artifact display cases, 180-degree video footage and an impressive line up of cars.

<u>Design and Engineering Gallery</u>-Display *Driven by Design* entertains, educates, and inspires by using interactive elements, artifacts, hands-on objects, and motion-activated content to learn about the design history of the Corvette.

<u>Corvette Hall of Fame</u>-Located in the SkyDome, the Hall of Fame was established in 1998 to provide official recognition to those influential persons in Corvette history and honor their achievements.

<u>Limited Engagement Gallery</u>-"CARisma: The Legendary Creations of Carl Casper." Casperproduced car shows have entertained car enthusiasts nationwide for decades. Included in the exhibit are The Batman Returns Batmobile, Turbo Shark Corvette/Cosmic Invader, Young American Dragster/51 Merc "knight Cruiser," and more.

<u>The McMichael Family Education Gallery</u>- Opening in early 2023, this 2000 square-foot education gallery will provide state-of-the-art educational experience aimed at the next generation of Corvette enthusiasts, engineers, and designers.

2024 National Corvette Museum Caravan

Sponsorship Overview & Fee Schedule

The National Corvette Museum (NCM) Caravans have become an integral part of the National Corvette culture. The following provides some background information on these caravans.

A nationwide caravan was organized in 1994 to celebrate the opening of the National Corvette Museum and again in 1999 to commemorate the NCM's 5th anniversary. In 2003, a 3rd National Caravan was organized to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Corvette marque. The 2009, 2014 and 2019 National Corvette Caravans were held to celebrate the NCM's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary. We are now preparing for the 2024 National Corvette Caravan to celebrate the NCM's 30th anniversary.

Local caravans will be organized across the country and in most cases they will merge with other local groups as they proceed to Bowling Green, Ky. It is anticipated that more than 300 Corvettes will participate in our regional caravan and will join 7500+ other Corvettes in Bowling Green at the conclusion of the caravan.

Our local caravan covers Corvette enthusiasts in North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and Maryland. It will originate in NC days before with our own events and depart for Bowling Green with an overnight stop in Sevierville, TN. After combining with other caravan participants, our caravan will arrive in Bowling Green, KY on August 28, 2024 for the weekend festivities at the NCM.

Each caravan is left to its own resources to raise the funds required for the activities at the origination site, overnight stops, Route Books and caravan materials. The NC/SC/VA/MD Corvette Caravan will be solely funded through corporate sponsorships. Sponsorships will be available in a variety of levels for businesses wishing to advertise to local Corvette enthusiasts and support the caravan and NCM.

Our NC/SC/VA/MD Corvette Caravan's primary fund-raising tool will be to sell ads in our 2024 Caravan Route Book. The attached Fee Schedule shows the rate structure for these ads but we would be pleased to meet with you and tailor a package that would provide the maximum benefit for your business. A representative can also show you samples of our previous Caravan Route Books and discuss the options.

Additionally, sponsors who commit their support at specified levels will have their ads placed on our NC/SC/VA/MD 2024 Corvette Caravan webpage with links to the sponsor's webpage that can be seen by Corvette enthusiasts visiting our site.

Planning an event this size takes considerable time and resources. To help facilitate our early start, the NC/SC/VA/MD 2024 Corvette Caravan is raising money now for planning, organizing and operating the event If possible, we would appreciate a commitment of support at your earliest convenience. Steve Argubright's Special Sighting

On my way to the club breakfast on April 1, I came across this Corvette being towed behind a U-Haul. The antique Virginia license plate was dated 1954, so this must have been a real barn find!! From what I read, in 1954 most Corvettes were white but two new colors were added, Pennant Blue and Guardsman or Sportsman Red (take your pick). A few black ones were also built. The driver and I exchanged "thumbs up" and he had a big smile on his face. I can't imagine why.

<u>Editor's Note</u>:

If its original color was black, it is, indeed, a rare '54 Corvette (only a half dozen or so were painted black). However, it's probably a repaint in a non-original color. Looks like it might be a "resto-mod," i.e., modified with custom wheels/tires, some de-chroming on the exterior

(it's missing the side chrome trim strips), and maybe a late-model V8 engine (replacing the original straight 6 cylinder engine). It also has a Plasticon brand aftermarket hardtop that was quite popular in the day (there was no factory hardtops until 1956). It's quite nice just the same. And it's especially nice for a C1 and a C8 (and their owners) to exchange greetings on the highway.

My '54 was originally Pennant blue with a beige interior; there were only about 300 blue ones. Mine was repainted white (around 1984) and then red (around 1985 and again in 2011) and the interior was changed to red (there were only about 100 original '54 red ones.) My intention is to make it blue again; I have all the beige interior pieces needed to make the interior color change to go with the exterior color change—I <u>only</u> have to strip off all of the paint, then prep and repaint the car in Pennant Blue.

What Did You Do to Your Corvette?!!

Paul & Beth Thompson — 1971 Stingray convertible

Oh the challenge of the parts search for our (Thompson's) 1971 Corvette Stingray! The driver's side windshield wiper was an issue for years, but finally came to a head with the ACCC Toys for Tots drive to the USMC Museum at Quantico, VA, in December 2022. It was a rainy day and when I switched them on, the driver's side wiper wouldn't budge. Thanks to a liberal application of Rain-X, the rain drops flowed off enough to maintain visibility. But that forced an intense search for the wiper transmission part that Lester Long, owner of My Auto Shop in Woodbridge, VA, had recommended the last time I had it in for inspection. I called several parts shops that a Google search had identified. Eckler's was the biggest disappointment, seemingly one step away from bankruptcy. Next was Zip Corvette parts in Mechanicsville, VA, and after identifying the issue they recommended a wiper arm assembly and clamps which I bought. Upon receipt, I realized that it would not solve the root issue which was the stripped driver side three bolt wiper transmission hub, which the wiper arm fits on top of as seen in the

picture on the right. A call to Zip resulted in a referral to Piper's Auto Specialties in Vermilion, IL. When the 89 year old J T Piper answered, he knew exactly what I was talking about and said he had a used wiper transmission assembly in stock. It was worth the call just to talk to this gentleman about life (mostly his) in general, and Corvettes in particular. Although he was extremely hard of hearing, his son-in-law called back the next day and got our address squared away, thus averting delivery of a \$175 part to 16022 Kings Mountain Rd. I don't think that address exists. (Al McCloud up the street maybe?? Ha, ha)

Upon removal of the wiper cover, Lester Long installed the wiper transmission, wiper arm assembly and clamps, made final adjustments to preclude interference of the wiper arms with each other and re-installed the wiper



cover. He also replaced the flasher unit and changed the oil and filter. I have been using full synthetic 10W-30 in the Jasper 350 CI engine, replaced in 2013.

Now that the wipers and turn signals are in working order, it is time to get back on the road with the ACCC. Very sorry to hear that Corvette Weekend was cancelled, but without COVID restrictions, there are now plenty of other opportunities to cruise.


