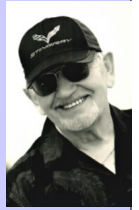

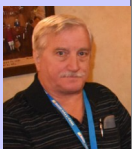

2024 National Corvette Museum Caravan

Sponsorship Overview & Fee Schedule

The National Corvette Museum (NCM) Caravans have become an integral part of the National Corvette culture. The following provides some background information on these caravans.

A nationwide caravan was organized in 1994 to celebrate the opening of the National Corvette Museum and again in 1999 to commemorate the NCM's 5th anniversary. In 2003, a 3rd National Caravan was organized to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Corvette marque. The 2009, 2014 and 2019 National Corvette Caravans were held to celebrate the NCM's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary. We are now preparing for the 2024 National Corvette Caravan to celebrate the NCM's 30th anniversary.

Local caravans will be organized across the country and in most cases they will merge with other local groups as they proceed to Bowling Green, Ky. It is anticipated that more than 300 Corvettes will participate in our regional caravan and will join 7500+ other Corvettes in Bowling Green at the conclusion of the caravan.

Our local caravan covers Corvette enthusiasts in North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and Maryland. It will originate in NC days before with our own events and depart for Bowling Green with an overnight stop in Sevierville, TN. After combining with other caravan participants, our caravan will arrive in Bowling Green, KY on August 28, 2024 for the weekend festivities at the NCM.

Each caravan is left to its own resources to raise the funds required for the activities at the origination site, overnight stops, Route Books and caravan materials. The NC/SC/VA/MD Corvette Caravan will be solely funded through corporate sponsorships. Sponsorships will be available in a variety of levels for businesses wishing to advertise to local Corvette enthusiasts and support the caravan and NCM.

Our NC/SC/VA/MD Corvette Caravan's primary fund-raising tool will be to sell ads in our 2024 Caravan Route Book. The attached Fee Schedule shows the rate structure for these ads but we would be pleased to meet with you and tailor a package that would provide the maximum benefit for your business. A representative can also show you samples of our previous Caravan Route Books and discuss the options.

Additionally, sponsors who commit their support at specified levels will have their ads placed on our NC/SC/VA/MD 2024 Corvette Caravan webpage with links to the sponsor's webpage that can be seen by Corvette enthusiasts visiting our site.

Planning an event this size takes considerable time and resources. To help facilitate our early start, the NC/SC/VA/MD 2024 Corvette Caravan is raising money now for planning, organizing and operating the event. We plan on publishing the Route Book in early 2024 and distributing it soon thereafter. 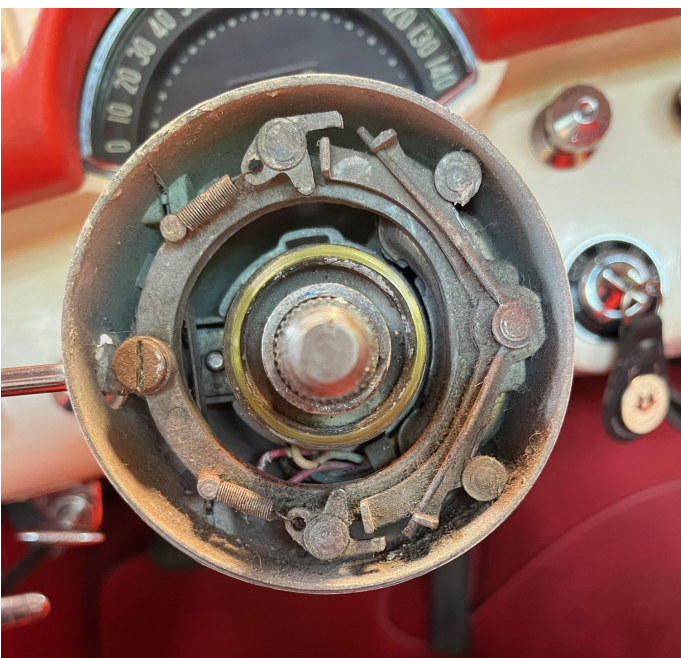
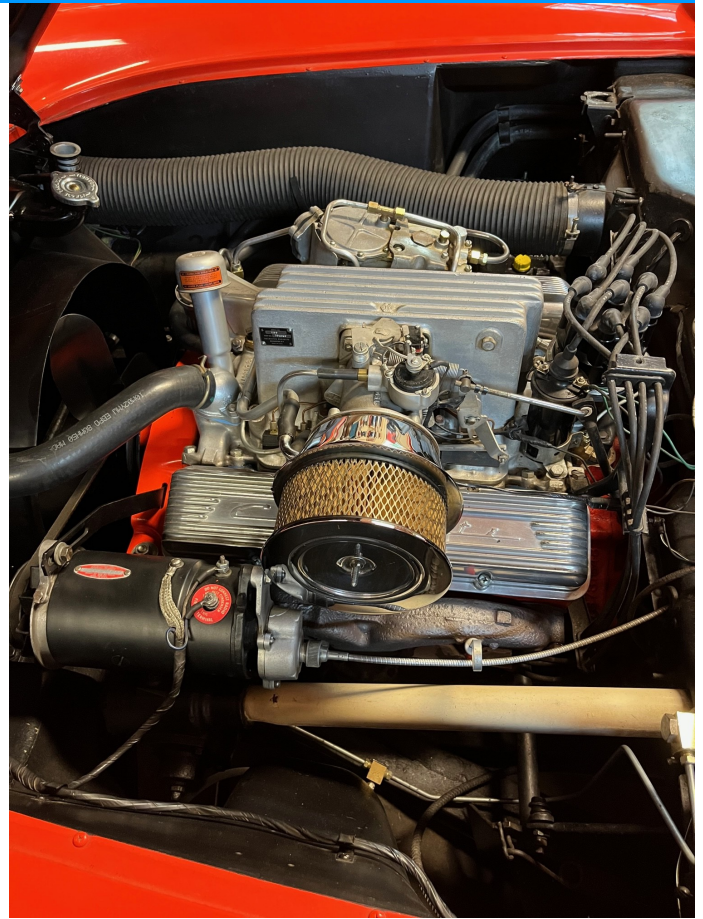

What Did You Do to Your Corvette?!! (cont'd)

Pete Rutledge — 1957 Corvette

You'll remember from the last issue that I was working on getting the '57 back on the road after a long dormant period. After its first extended ride in the neighborhood, the temperature gauge approached 220 deg F and it regurgitated coolant from the radiator. Oddly enough, the coolant coming out of the top of the radiator was cool. On the next attempt, I used an infrared thermometer from Harbor Freight and aimed it at the upper radiator hose while the engine was warming up, in order to determine if the thermostat was opening once the coolant reached 180 deg F; it didn't. So, evidently, the 11 year old thermostat was stuck shut, not allowing coolant to circulate through the cooling system. I replaced the thermostat with a new one from AutoZone and all was well.



On my neighborhood drives I had also noticed that the turn signal stalk would not stay in the right turn position when approaching a right turn. So I removed the steering wheel and cleaned and lubricated the turn signal mechanism. After that, the turn signal functioned as intended, but I had also realigned the steering wheel while I was at it (it had been previously mounted off-center) and now the steering wheel was crooked when going straight down the road. I subsequently straightened the steering wheel by adjusting a link between the steering box pitman arm and the steering bell-crank. Now the wheel is straight when the car is going straight. I'm pretty confident that I'll be able to drive the car to the Corvette show at Bomnin Chevrolet in Manassas in August. Hope to see you there.
