

### National Corvette Museum Exhibits

--March 15 - <u>LUSTER:</u> <u>Realism and Hyperrealism in Contemporary Automobile and Motorcycle</u> <u>Painting</u>

A traveling museum exhibit of over 55 paintings by present day realists and hyperrealists who specialize in automobiles and motorcycles as their primary subject matter. The exhibit will be on display through the end of 2024

--April - The Vintage Shop Opens on CorvetteStore.com

The Corvette Store's Vintage Shop will provide an opportunity to showcase Corvette history through fashions that have defined Corvette through the years. Of the nearly 2,000,000 Corvettes built since 1953, this is the 1,114<sup>th</sup>.

Manufactured Apr. 5, 1954—originally metallic Pennant Blue w/beige interior; likely to be one of the first few blue Corvettes ever (prior to

this, Corvettes were available only in white). Has its original numbersmatching 150 hp, triplecarbureted, 235 cubic inch straight six cylinder "Blue Flame" engine and cast iron Powerglide automatic transmission (the engine design dates back to the first overhead valve in-line six cylinder marketed by Chevrolet in 1929).

Was "body-off-theframe" restored in approx. 1984 by Joe Trybulec, at which time it was repainted white with red interior; in approx. 1985 it was repainted again in red. It was last repainted around 2011.



#814 in original blue and in white repaint circa 1984

Has had 17 owners (counting auto sales companies).

From 1985 to 2008 (23 years), this car was owned by and on display in the showroom of Albrecht-Hamlin Chevrolet in Wood River, IL.

Has been auctioned twice by Mecum and twice on eBay.


