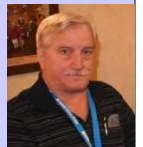

I sat there just watching, at loss for a word,

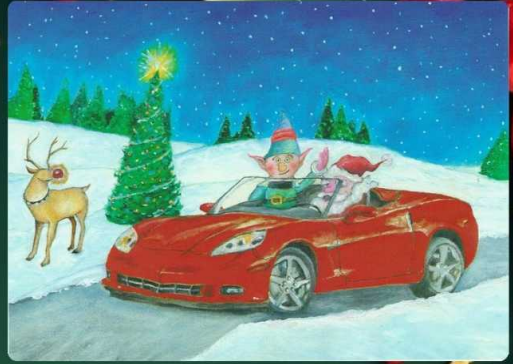
Then I heard him exclaim as we blasted from sight,


On behalf of the staff, the board and those we serve, we cannot thank you enough for your support!

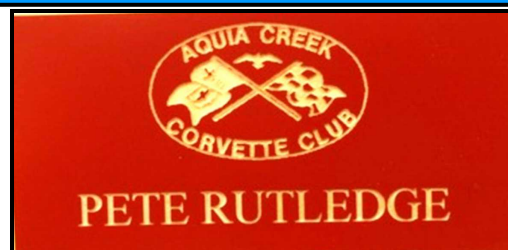
